

# Fans Want Ugly Betty to Attract Emmy Award

With the Emmy Awards less than a week away, TV fans have selected their picks for best new drama and comedy of the year.

Twenty-five percent (25%) of TV fans said

*Ugly Betty*

should be this year's Emmy winner. The freshman show, found exclusively on ABC, beat out last year's first choice, CBS'

.

*The Office*,

starring [Steve Carell](#)

, fell to a distant third at 18%. Finishing up the category, 8% want to see HBO's hit

*Entourage*

bring home an award, while 5% want

*30 Rock*

to win.

For this survey, TV fans are defined as Americans who regularly watch sitcoms, dramas or comedies on television.

These figures are similar to those when we asked viewers, regardless of who they want to win, who they think will win. Twenty-five percent (25%) of TV fans think

*Ugly Betty*

will win the Emmy.

*Two and a Half Men*

and

*The Office*

tied at 20%.

*Entourage*

and

*30 Rock*

hit rock bottom again at 11% and 8% respectively.

As for best drama, medical shows

[Grey's Anatomy and House](#)

grabbed top honors for the second year in a row.

*Grey's Anatomy*

beat out

*House*

slightly, however, 29% to 21%. Meanwhile, 13% want NBC's newest critically acclaimed show

*Heroes*

to win the award. An equal percentage said the same about ABC's show,

*Boston Legal*

. Just 12% wish

*The Sopranos*

would win.

Regardless of who they want to win, 31% believe

*Grey's Anatomy*

will win. And though just 12% want  
*The Sopranos*  
to win, 22% think the show will win.  
*Heroes*

,  
*House*,  
and  
*Boston Legal*  
fall far behind.
